Picture Porter 35 is the first device designed specifically as a Digital Photo Manager. It's the perfect digital camera companion to replace your notebook computer and allow you to travel light when you are out in the field on a photo shoot or on vacation.

Even at home or around town, you'll find many different ways to use the Picture Porter 35 in your everyday life. It becomes your digital portfolio or family digital photo album where you'll store years and years of photo collections for quick and easy retrieval.



How will you use Picture Porter 35?

Copy and access memory cards and USB storage devices

Securely back up your digital camera memory card

Connect a broad range of memory card formats directly to Picture Porter 35 and back up its contents to the large capacity hard drive.

Back up your memory card contents directly to a USB storage device

Make a primary or redundant, secondary backup of your memory card directly to a USB storage device.

Access memory card and USB storage devices

View the contents of connected memory devices on the Picture Porter 35 screen.

Copy photos and files between different memory devices

Copy a selection of photos and other files between various memory devices connected to Picture Porter 35.



View and review your photos anytime you need

View RAW photo images

View RAW file format images from a wide selection of DSLRs including models from Canon, Nikon, Fuji, Olympus, Sony, Leica, Phase One, Pentax, and Panasonic.

Display photos in full screen view

Review your photos on the full screen manually at your own pace or in an automatic slideshow.

Search for specific photos quickly in thumbnail view

Browse photos in a 3x2 or 5x4 matrix of thumbnails to quickly identify and select specific photos from a large set.

Examine fine details in zoom mode

Zoom and pan a photo to inspect a particular portion in more detail.

Display photo EXIF and Histogram information

Gather in depth photo information from the EXIF metadata and histogram.



Share photos and other files conveniently

Supports a large variety of storage device formats

A full range of memory card formats and USB storage devices can be connected to Picture Porter 35 to facilitate file sharing.

Back up the entire Picture Porter 35 to protect from losing valuable data

Copy the entire Picture Porter 35 hard drive to USB external hard drive

The entire Picture Porter 35 hard drive can be backed up without a computer to an external hard drive connected through the USB-OTG cable.

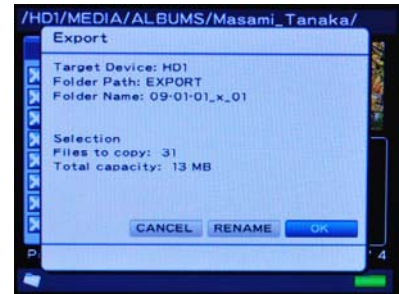
Manage your photos and other files

❑ Rough edit anywhere

Picture Porter 35 becomes an integral part of your workflow.

When you have free time during a shoot, whether on the plane or in a long taxi ride, use the Export feature to make a copy of your selected photos to the Export folder.

After returning to your computer, copy the *Backup* folder contents (originals) to your data storage archive and copy the *Export* folder contents (selection for editing) to your working directory.



❑ Copy and paste selection

Copy and paste a selection of files and folders between different locations on the Picture Porter 35 hard drive or between different memory devices.

❑ Create folders and rename folders and files

Organize your files and folders so that you can easily locate and access your data.

Record PhotoMemo[®] audio messages associated with selected photos

❑ Make mental notes for your photos

While the ideas are fresh in your mind, make audio notes for your photos to review when you are ready to edit.

❑ Personalize your photo slideshow with your own voice

Create a fun photo slideshow for your family and friends with personal audio messages introducing each photo.



❑ For business, enhance the slideshow presentation with pre-recorded material

Record your presentation of each slide beforehand so you make sure to send the perfect message. Or, let it play on its own when you aren't even there.

Make and enjoy multimedia slideshows

Combine photos and videos in the same slideshow

Enhance the slideshow experience by combining photos and videos to play together in the same slideshow.

Add music to the slideshow

Embellish a themed slideshow with suitable background music.

Make titled slideshows that show a text message with each photo

Utilize the IPTC description field to add a text message with each photo as it is displayed on the slideshow.

Create a slideshow with audio announcements

Use the PhotoMemo feature to record audio messages for each photo that will be announced as the slideshow transitions from photo to photo.

View the slideshow at your own pace

Pause the slideshow and advance the photos manually at your own pace. This gives you the flexibility to share and discuss each slideshow photo with your audience.

Play music

Listen to songs or other audio files on Picture Porter 35 through the built-in speaker or with stereo earphones.

View videos

Play supported video files on Picture Porter 35.



Create and edit Playlists of your collections quickly and easily

❑ Make a unique Playlist by adding selections of photos, videos and music

A simple menu option allows you to add selected photos, video, and music files to a new or existing Playlist.



❑ Change sequence of files in a Playlist

Adjust the sequence of items in a Playlist so the slideshow plays in your desired order.

❑ Export Playlist files to copy on a memory card, USB device, or computer

Make a copy of the files in a Playlist for easy transfer and sharing.



❑ Duplicate existing Playlist for editing

Create variations of a Playlist from an existing one by adding new files to or deleting current files from its duplicate.

❑ Share Playlist to another Picture Porter 35

Copy a Playlist along with the original files to a second Picture Porter 35 connected by the USB-OTG cable.



❑ Create empty Playlists for future use

Create any number of Playlists to help organize different files for different purposes. You can add photos, videos, and music files to specific Playlists as the need arises.

Access IPTC metadata

❑ View core IPTC metadata on the screen

For photos that contain IPTC metadata, you can view the metadata on the screen to learn about the descriptions and copyright information associated with the photo.
